	Obtain a program outline and plan a timeline for completing the course.
	Each of these courses – EDUC 135, EDUC 136, and EDUC 208 requires 15 hours of observation/field experience in Early Childhood settings/schools. Please avoid taking these courses during the same semester.
	If you have college credits from another school, contact an MC transcript evaluator at Germantown, Rockville, or Takoma Park/Silver Spring for transcript evaluation as soon as possible, so that you find out early what courses in your transcript can be transferred to the A. A. S. degree program.
