• Essay Question Responses

ACET applicants who do not have applicable experience as an MCPS paraeducator or substitute teacher must complete visits to Montgomery County Public Schools at the grade level/subject area of interest. Following the visit(s), on separate pages, respond to each of the following questions; your response should require no more than one page per question. Be sure to include the names of schools you visited or in which you worked.

Q1. Based on your visits to Montgomery County Public Schools (or your experience as an MCPS substitute teacher or paraeducator), discuss two specific areas where you witnessed teachers who excelled in meeting students' needs and explain why.

Q2. What are two of the biggest challenges teachers face to implement effective instruction in the current school environments (virtual or in-person)? Where do you see opportunities for changes in teaching approach related to these challenges?

Q3. What do you see as your strengths in being able to adapt and contribute to student learning under the unique circumstances of the post-Covid world? Explain your commitment to student success regardless of the environment in which it is happening.

Q4. ACET strives to prepare effective teachers. The program is rigorous and accelerated with fastpaced coursework and intensity in collaboration, assignments and assessments. Explain how you think this is a good program "match" for you and how you plan to manage a work and life balance in such a program.
