# Articulated College Credit

## Do you know about this?

You may be able to earn up to nine articulated college credits from Montgomery College (MC).

### What are the requirements?

You will be eligible for up to nine MC college credits if

- You have earned a B or better in all the required Child & Adolescent Development courses at your high school in Montgomery County
- Your portfolio shows evidence of learning outcomes of those required courses
- Your Daily Log of Activities from the internship experience is complete

## How do | proceed?

- 1. Students should obtain a copy of the Articulation Agreement Credit Award Form from their Early Child Development teacher or the School of Education office at MC.
- 2. Students must complete the form, mark the letter grade obtained for each articulated course, and return the completed form to their Early Child Development teacher, who will check grades for accuracy, sign the form, and forward it to the registrar at the student's home school.
- 3. Students will pick up the form and a copy of their high school transcript from the registrar and deliver it, with their portfolio, to the Administrative Aide for the MC School of Education, Rockville Campus, Computer Science 120.
- 4. After reviewing the portfolio, the MC Early Childhood Coordinator will complete the Credit Award Form with the courses to be approved and forward all documents to the MC Registrar for awarding of credit. A copy of the award form will be returned to the student along with the portfolio.

## When do | receive the credit?

The credit will be granted upon admission to MC (within two years of graduation from Montgomery County Public Schools) in one of these Early Childhood Education programs:

- Early Childhood Education Technology, A.A.S. (Program Code 315)
- Early Childhood Education Certificate (Program Code 177)
- Early Childhood Education Teacher Transfer Program, A.A.T. (Program Code 604)
