NURS 125- Nursing in Health and Illness I

Course Description

NURS 125: Nursing in Health and Illness I Introductory medical surgical nursing course which builds on the conceptual foundations and core integrated nursing concepts taught in previous courses. Nursing concepts are applied in an interdisciplinary practice environment where emphasized. **PREREQUISITE(S): NURS 113, NURS 114, NURS 121. PRE-or COREQUISITE(S):** *A grade of C or better in mathematics foundation,* **BIOL 212, PSYC 100** *or consent of program coordinator.* **COREQUISITE(S): NURS126.** *Two hours lecture, twelve hours of clinical each week.*
