Michelle Humphreys

Dr. Michelle Humphreys is Lecturer in Percussion at Maryland's Towson University, and is Percussion Mentor and performing artist for the National Music Festival at Washington College.

She is principal percussionist with Opera Lafayette of Washington, D.C. and performs regularly with many of the region's top early music and modern ensembles including Washington Bach Consort, Folger Consort, New Music Ensemble at Towson University, National Cathedral Baroque Orchestra, Tempesta di Mare of Philadelphia, Handel Choir of Baltimore, Bach Sinfonia, Two Rivers Chamber Orchestra, and Chesapeake Orchestra at St. Mary's College of Maryland.

Highlights of her most recent two seasons include performing Michael Daugherty's concerto for timpani and wind ensemble, *Raise the Roof*, and performances at Kennedy Center, Lincoln Center, Royal Opera at the Palace of Versailles, Philadelphia's Kimmel Center, and Washington National Cathedral.

Dr. Humphreys was recently featured on several Spanish Baroque chamber music programs. She has also recorded seven French Baroque operas with Opera Lafayette for the Naxos label, including several modern-day premieres. She is a member of the Vic Firth Education Team and a proud endorser of Grover Pro Percussion and Zildjian cymbals.

Jack Barry

Jack Barry is a senior Music Performance major at Towson University. He attended Centennial High School under the direction of Dr. Max Vanderbeek. Before beginning percussion studies at Towson, he studied with Scott Tiemann and Mike Harrison.

Casey Isanogle

Casey Isanogle served five years in the US Marine Corps and marched for the Reading Buccaneers Drum Corp before beginning his studies in Music Education at Towson. He attended Walkersville High School, under band directors Damon Dye and Davoid Francescina.

Gilbert Rupp

Gilbert Rupp is a sophomore Music Education major at Towson University. He attended Tuscarora High School under the direction of John Karos, and prior to beginning percussion studies at Towson, he studied with Greg Herron.

Rob Putt

Rob Putt taught instrumental music in the Montgomery County Public Schools for 17 years. He plays bassoon in the Rockville Concert Band where he is also the assistant conductor.

Vincent Patterson

Dr. Vincent Patterson is the founder and Director of the Maryland Band Directors Band. His Doctor of Musical Arts Degree in conducting is from Catholic University, and his degrees in instrumental performance and music education are from Millikin University. In the U.S. Army, he taught at the Armed Forces School of Music in Norfolk, after which he was accepted into the U.S. Marine Band, *The President's Own*. He has sung with the Washington National Opera chorus, has been a member of the Choir of Men and Boys at Washington National Cathedral and the choirs of The National Shrine, St. Paul's Church, and St. Matthews Cathedral. From 1995 to 2010, he was the conductor of the Rockville Concert Band, for which the City of Rockville gave him its Lifetime Achievement in the Arts award in 2007.
