

SCHOLARSHIP SEARCH TOOLS

Big Future (by The College Board) allows website users to search for scholarships, financial aid, and internships from more than 2,200 programs, totaling nearly \$6 billion. Enter personal information, academic information, type of award (need- or merit-based), or affiliation information to obtain the most relevant search results. <https://bigfuture.collegeboard.org/scholarship-search>

College Greenlight is a college and scholarship search site aimed at connecting "first generation and underrepresented students to caring colleges, generous scholarships, and life-changing counselors and mentors." Users create a profile indicating whether they are a high-school student, college student, parent, counselor, or mentor. Included are college profiles, a large online scholarship database, and support with tracking colleges and scholarships. <https://www.collegegreenlight.com/>

FastWeb draws on a database of more than 1.5 million scholarships to match users' profile information with the best scholarships for them. In addition to targeted scholarship information, FastWeb provides college search and financial aid information as well as career advice. <http://www.fastweb.com/>

International Financial Aid and College Scholarship Search is a prime resource for financial aid, college scholarship, and grant information if you are a U.S. or international student seeking to study abroad. <http://www.iefaf.org/>

SallieMae Scholarship Search combines search technology with current scholarship information to provide users with a customized list of scholarship leads. Scholarships.com taps a database of 3.7 million scholarships and grants worth \$19 billion to match users with relevant financial support.
