

Learning Center Reopening Information

Montgomery College Learning Centers are excited to reopen for limited in-person services. This page will provide regular updates during our gradual, phased reopening.

With the health and safety of learning center users and staff our priority, we have modified our physical spaces as follows:

- Plexiglass barriers at service desks
- Physical distancing protocols
- Hand sanitizing stations in multiple locations throughout each learning center
- Reduced number of public computers, tables, and/or seating to support physical distancing
- Disinfecting wipes for self-service in multiple locations throughout each learning center
- COVID-19 specific established cleaning protocols from MC Facilities, including frequent cleaning of all campus spaces multiple times per day.

Effective Monday, August 2, face coverings (masks) are required for all individuals (employees, students, contractors, and guests) who are indoors at Montgomery College, regardless of their vaccination status. We also request that all visitors continue to follow CDC guidance on how to best protect yourself and others: maintain physical distance, wash your hands frequently, and stay home and contact your doctor if you have any COVID-19 symptoms.
