A current M# is required to log in. Computers contain the Microsoft Office 2016 suite and a variety of accessibility programs. An ADA workstation is also available. Other technology in the library includes laptops and tablets available for two-hour loan periods, a high-speed scanner, a One Button Studio for easy video creation, a Collaborative Workstation that allows groups to connect multiple devices to a single screen, group study rooms with a large wall monitor, print stations, charging stations for a variety of devices, and a range of cables available for check-out. Additional resources include research assistance via online guides, tutorials, and a 24/7 librarian chat service, textbook lending, print and online collections covering all subjects taught at MC, and a variety of spaces for both silent and group study.
