AAS in Architectural/Construction Technology, Architectural Technology Track to the BS in Architecture and Environmental Design

AAS in Architectural/Construction Technology, Management of Construction Track to the BS in Construction Management

AGREEMENT

This Articulation Agreement serves as the formal collaboration document for Montgomery College (MC) and Morgan State University (Morgan) to deliver a seamless pathway between MC's AAS in Architectural/Construction Technology, Architectural Technology Track to the BS in Architecture and Environmental Design and MC's AAS in Architectural/Construction Technology, Management of Construction Track to the BS in Construction Management.

PROVISIONS OF THE AGREEMENT

- 1. The institutions agree to follow the joint program curriculum and course-by-course articulation delineated in this document.
- 2. Both educational institutions will cooperate toward developing, disseminating, and presenting the articulated program information to students.
- 3. Graduates of MC who have completed the AAS in Architectural/Construction Technology, Architectural Technology Track or AAS in Architectural/Construction Technology, Management of Construction Track with a cumulative grade point average of 2.0 or higher will be considered for admission to Morgan as an BS in Architecture and Environmental Design or BS in Construction Management major in accordance with Morgan State University's Transfer Student Policy.
- 4. Students intending to transfer should apply for admission by the priority deadline for the semester for which they intend to enroll.
- 5. Students are subject to all the policies and procedures of both institutions.
- 6. This articulation agreement is based on the present curricula contained in this document. Changes to curriculum can be made without completing the signatory process. The degree requirements will be reviewed biennially; the agreement will be reviewed every five years at which time the agreement can be renewed or ended upon the mutual written consent of both parties
- 7. Both institutions at any time may initiate changes to this articulation agreement. Changes should be shared in written format, executed by both parties, via email or USPS, with at least 30-day's notice for implementation.
- 8. Notwithstanding any other provision of this articulation agreement, all information relating to student educational records shall be treated in accordance with Maryland law and the Federal Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA).
- 9. This articulation agreement will be governed by the laws of the State of Maryland.
