MONTGOMERY COLLEGE, SALISBURY UNIVERSITY, AND THE UNIVERSITIES AT SHADY GROVE PROGRAM ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

AA in Exercise Science to the

Bachelor of Science Degree in Exercise Science (Health Minor)
Valid from: fall semester 2018 through spring semester 2023

AGREEMENT

This Articulation Agreement serves as the formal partnership document for Montgomery College and Salisbury University to deliver a seamless pathway between Montgomery College's AA in Exercise Science and Salisbury University's Bachelor of Science Degree Program in Exercise Science.

PROVISIONS OF THE AGREEMENT

- 1. The institutions agree to follow the joint program curriculum and course-by-course articulation delineated in this document.
- 2. Both educational institutions will cooperate toward developing, disseminating, and presenting the articulated program information to students.
- 3. Graduates of the Montgomery College program who have completed the AA in Exercise Science with a cumulative grade point average of 2.0 or higher will be considered for admission to Salisbury University as an Exercise Science major at the Shady Grove campus. Twenty-four seats will be granted to the top applicants, based on GPA, every fall semester.
- 4. All articulated course credits earned with a C or better will be accepted for transfer according to the program matrix. General Education courses, not used as major requirements, will only require a D.
- 5. Students intending to transfer should apply for admission by the priority deadline for the semester for which they intend to enroll.
- 6. Students intending to transfer should submit an Intent to Enroll form to the Shady Grove Program Coordinator by March 15 of each year.
- 7. Admission to the Exercise Science Program at the Shady Grove campus is a two-step process. Students must apply to Salisbury by the priority deadline, be accepted to SU, submit an Intent to Enroll form by the deadline, and be accepted to the Shady Grove program. Shady Grove acceptance letters are mailed on May 15 of each year.
- 8. Students are subject to all the policies and procedures of all institutions.
- 9. This articulation agreement is based on the present curricula contained in this document and it is effective for a five-year period from fall 2018-spring 2023. Prior to the end of the spring 2023 semester, the agreement will be renewed or updated, as appropriate.
- 10. All institutions at any time may initiate changes to this articulation agreement. Changes should be shared in written format, via email or USPS, with at least 30-day's notice for implementation.

11. All parties agree to adhere to Maryland State Law and FERPA Regulations pertaining to student information, transfer of credits, and legal statue.

As part of this agreement, the following have been included:

- 1. Course—by-course articulations (equivalencies), including satisfaction of general education requirements at both Montgomery College and Salisbury University.
- 2. Recommended Course Guide for completion of AA and BS requirements.
- 3. Course substitutions for Montgomery College students without degree.

Signatories

This agreement represents our understanding that students who adhere to the requirements will have the ability to transfer from the AA in Exercise Science offered at Montgomery College to the Bachelor of Science degree in Exercise Science offered at Salisbury University.
