WHAT IS THE TEAS?

The Test of Essential Academic Skills, or TEAS, is a timed, computer based, multiple choice test used by Health Sciences programs to evaluate the academic preparedness of entry-level health sciences students.

Montgomery College administers the **ATI TEAS, Version 6**. The test consists of four content areas: reading comprehension, mathematics, science, and English and language usage. There are a total of 170 multiple choice questions. Test-takers are allotted 209 minutes (approximately 3 hours and 29 minutes) to complete the exam.

WHAT IS THE REQUIRED TEAS SCORE AT MONTGOMERY COLLEGE?

TEAS Test Scores for Montgomery College Health Sciences Programs:

Reading = 70% and Total (Composite) Score - 66%.

THE TEAS TESTING PROCESS

- A. REGISTRATION:** In order to take the TEAS at Montgomery College, an applicant must be admitted as an active Montgomery College student. A student MC identification number is required to complete ATI registration. Students register and pay for the TEAS through the Assessment Technologies Institute (ATI) website at <https://www.atitesting.com>.
 - B. RETEST POLICY:** At Montgomery College, students may only take the TEAS twice during a twelve (12) month period, starting with the first attempt. After the first attempt, students must wait 30 days before they can retake the exam.
 - C. WHAT TO BRING TO THE TEST SITE:** One form of photo identification: United States or state government-issued photo ID, international passport, or Montgomery College student ID card.
