

PLACEMENT TEST EXEMPTION CRITERIA

Students: You *may* be exempt from taking the [ACCUPLACER](#) or [ACCUPLACER ESL](#) placement exams if you meet *at least one* of the following criteria:

- PASSED ENGLISH COMPOSITION** - If you have completed a credited/college-level English Composition course with a grade of “C” or better from an accredited U.S. college or university please submit an official or unofficial transcript to the [Office of Enrollment Services](#). Keep in mind that you may still need to take the math portion of the ACCUPLACER unless you are eligible for exemption.
- EARNED DEGREE** - If you have earned an associate’s degree or higher from a regionally accredited U.S. college or university please submit an official transcript showing the degree conferred with date to the [Office of Enrollment Services](#). Keep in mind that you may still need to take the math portion of the ACCUPLACER unless you are eligible for exemption.
- ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP) or INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE (IB) exams** - If you have AP or IB exams, please submit your official records to the [Office of Enrollment Services](#) for evaluation. - APPROPRIATE STANDARDIZED TEST SCORES** – You may be exempt by submitting official minimum qualifying SAT, ACT or PARCC scores:

****NOTE:** Students with PARCC scores must see a counselor or academic advisor to process and analyze these scores.

- ALTERNATIVE PLACEMENT PROGRAM (APP)** - In accordance with Montgomery College’s partnership with Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS), course performance in select classes may qualify you to take college courses through the Alternate Placement Program (APP). Contact your MCPS Dual Enrollment Program Assistant (DEPA) or email: dualenrollment@montgomerycollege.edu for more information.

6. **ADDITIONAL STANDARDIZED TEST SCORES** – You may be exempt from taking the English/Reading sections of the ACCUPLACER, or the ACCUPLACER ESL by submitting official minimum qualifying [Test of English as a Foreign Language](#) (TOEFL), [International English Language Testing System](#) (IELTS) and/or [Pearson Test of English Academic](#) (PTE) scores:

- TOEFL 575+ (paper and pencil test)
- TOEFL 90+ (internet-based test)
- IELTS 6.5+
- PTE 61 or higher (This does not replace, but is an addition to TOEFL and/or IELTS)

Students applying with these scores will still need to complete the math section of the ACCUPLACER to complete all assessment level requirements.

If you tested more than 5 years ago, it is strongly recommended that you take the appropriate college placement exam.

HOW DO I SUBMIT MY SCORES OR TRANSCRIPTS?

There are two methods for submitting scores to Montgomery College:

1. Print a copy of your *unofficial* scores or transcripts under the supervision of an authorized MC employee from the [Welcome Center](#), [Office of Enrollment Services](#), or [Counseling and Advising Department](#).

MCPS students may also coordinate with the [MCPS DEPA](#) to meet with a MC official during scheduled ACCUPLACER testing in the high school.

2. Request your official scores to be sent directly to the [Office of Enrollment Services](#) at Montgomery College from College Board, ETS, TOEFL, or a regionally accredited U.S. college or university. Montgomery College has three campuses: Germantown, Rockville and Takoma Park/Silver Spring. Please send your official scores to the campus where you plan to take your first semester of classes.

TRANSFER ACCUPLACER SCORES

If you have taken the ACCUPLACER at another institution within 2 years for English and reading and within 1 year for math, you may submit those scores by following the instructions on the [Placement Transfer Form](#).

NOTE: *Montgomery College does not accept ACCUPLACER ESL scores.*
