Refer to the Montgomery College Catalog for specific admissions requirements for these programs. Use the "pre" code associated with the program, e.g., 570 Pre-Nursing or 580 Pre-Physical Therapist Assistant, or you may choose any other Montgomery College major while your application to a health science program is pending. If unsure, contact a counselor for advice.

† Students planning to transfer to a four-year degree program in nursing are advised to check with the desired transfer institution to determine the requirements of the institution.
