

MONTGOMERY COLLEGE TRANSFER ADVISING BY MAJOR – PSYCHOLOGY Bachelor of Arts or Bachelor of Science [BA OR BS] – August 5, 2026

Transfer requirements for Psychology majors vary by school; check with each school of interest to determine which PSYC, MATH and Science courses are required. Consider MC's [General Studies SSAH AA degree](#) as an alternate path to select the Math and specific PSYC courses needed for your specific transfer school(s).

PSYC 200 Statistical Methods in Psych., taken after transfer to UM, has a MATH 120 = MC MATH 150 Applied Calculus prerequisite, therefore a STAT 100 (= MC MATH 117 Statistics) course at MC is not required. WHAT IF I TAKE MORE PSYC'S AT MC THAN ARE REQUIRED? You may take more PSYC's at MC beyond a transfer school's minimum requirements, however, additional 200-level PSYC's from MC may transfer as lower-level electives only, not as PSYC electives; this will not reduce the number of PSYC courses that must be taken at the upper-level after transfer.
