Harry E. Johnson has led the Washington, D.C. Martin Luther King, Jr. National Memorial Project Foundation since it was established in 2002, to honor the life and legacy of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., and to promote the Foundation's tenets of Democracy, Justice, Hope and Love: the Memorial was dedicated in 2011.

Johnson is a career lawyer, entrepreneur and public servant. From 2001 to 2004, he served as National President of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, overseeing more than 700 chapters across the USA .

Johnson has received extensive recognition for his public service, including the NAACP's Trailblazer award, Thurgood Marshall School of Law's Alumnus Of The Year, and Ebony Magazine's 100 Most Influential Black Americans from 2001 through 2004.

Johnson received his Doctor of Jurisprudence from Texas Southern University, and his Bachelor of Arts from Xavier University of Louisiana.
