Call for Proposals

Confluence brings together translators, interpreters, educators, and others interested in the field of translation, including its literary, practical, and philosophical dimensions. The conference offers interpretation and translation-focused presentations, and opportunities for discussion, virtual networking, career development, and celebration.

Confluence organizers are seeking proposals for virtual presentations to be held on **Saturday, April 9, 2022**. Presentation sessions will feature 60 minutes presentations or panels on translation, interpretation, and translation studies, including 10 minutes for Q&A. Proposals will be accepted in four tracks:

1. Techniques, practices, and problem-solving in translation/interpretation
2. Business of translation/interpretation
3. Art of literary translation
4. Education in translation/interpretation

Proposals are due by midnight, Friday March 11, 2022.
