Confluence brings together translators, interpreters, educators, and others interested in the field of translation, including its literary, practical, and philosophical dimensions. The conference offers interpretation and translation-focused workshops and presentations, and opportunities for discussion, networking, career development, and celebration.

Confluence organizers are seeking proposals for presentations and workshops to be held on Saturday, April 13, 2024, morning and afternoon: conference sessions will feature a variety of concurrent workshops and presentations on translation, interpretation, and translation studies. The day's schedule will offer opportunities for informal networking.

The organizers plan to group the workshops and presentations according to four tracks:

- 1. Techniques, practices, and problem-solving in translation/interpretation
- 2. Business of translation/interpretation
- 3. Art of literary translation/interpretation
- 4. Education in translation/interpretation

Proposals for workshops, panels, or other presentations are to include requirements for room setup and technical needs, if any. Conference rooms are equipped with a computer workstation, USB ports, CD player, internet access, and projection.
