

SUBMITTING OFFICIAL SAT/ACT SCORES FOR THE DUAL ENROLLMENT PROGRAM

High School students may submit qualifying SAT/ACT scores to grant them exemption from taking a placement exam:



	English/Reading Section Score			Math Section Score
SAT	480+ Ev. Based Read/Writing	OR	26+ Reading Subtest	530+ Math
ACT	21+ Reading			21+ Math

If any component of their SAT/ACT scores qualify, students can submit to MC by either:

- 1. Under supervision of an authorized MC staff member, student may log onto www.Collegeboard.org or www.ACT.org and print a copy of their scores.
- o <u>On-campus option</u>: Schedule an appointment with an MC Academic Coordinator.
- High School site option: Coordinate with MCPS
 DEPA to meet with MC official during scheduled
 ACCUPLACER testing in the high school.
- 2. Student may request scores be sent directly from College Board, Inc. or ACT, Inc. to the MC admissions office of the campus you will attend.
- o For details, search <u>Admissions & Records</u> using the link http://cms.montgomerycollege.edu/EDU/directory2.aspx
- May take up to three weeks to be sent and uploaded into MC system
- o Student must inform MC when scores have been requested.

Once scores are submitted, student can proceed with registration.

ADVANCED COURSES MAY REQUIRE HIGHER SAT/ACT SCORES TO GRANT EXEMPTION
