### WINTER 2019

Date	Action Item/ Deadline
Monday, September 30, 2019	The official listing of winter college courses published on the <a href="#">MC class schedule site</a> available for viewing only.
Monday October 7, 2019.	Student may begin the admission and registration process posted on the MC dual enrollment website ( <a href="http://www.montgomerycollege.edu/dep">www.montgomerycollege.edu/dep</a> ) for winter classes. Students will use the online enrollment management system “dualenroll.com” to complete their registration <u>request</u> .
Monday, October 14, 2019	The College’s DE office will begin officially registering students who have completed all dual enrollment steps.
Friday, December 13, 2019	Winter 2020 High School Grant application (submitted online) and 2018 federal tax documents (submitted to MC dual enrollment office) are DUE. Incomplete and late applications will not be processed.
Monday, December 23, 2019	Online-only college classes begin
Monday, January 6, 2020	Campus-based and short-session online college classes begin

### SPRING 2020

Date	Action Item/ Deadline
Monday, October 14, 2019	The official listing of spring college courses published on the <a href="#">MC class schedule site</a> available for viewing only.
Monday October 14, 2019.	Student may begin the admission and registration process posted on the MC dual enrollment website ( <a href="http://www.montgomerycollege.edu/dep">www.montgomerycollege.edu/dep</a> ) for spring classes. Students will use the online enrollment management system “dualenroll.com” to complete their registration <u>request</u> .
Monday, October 28, 2019	The College’s DE office will begin officially registering PRIORITY students who have completed all dual enrollment steps.
Monday, November 4, 2019	The College’s DE office will begin officially registering REGULAR students who have completed all dual enrollment steps.
Friday, January 10, 2020	Spring 2020 High School Grant application (submitted online) and 2018 federal tax documents (submitted to MC dual enrollment office) are DUE. Incomplete and late applications will not be processed.
Monday, January 27, 2020	Campus-based and on-line college classes begin.
Wednesday, January 29, 2020	High school/USG site college classes begin.
