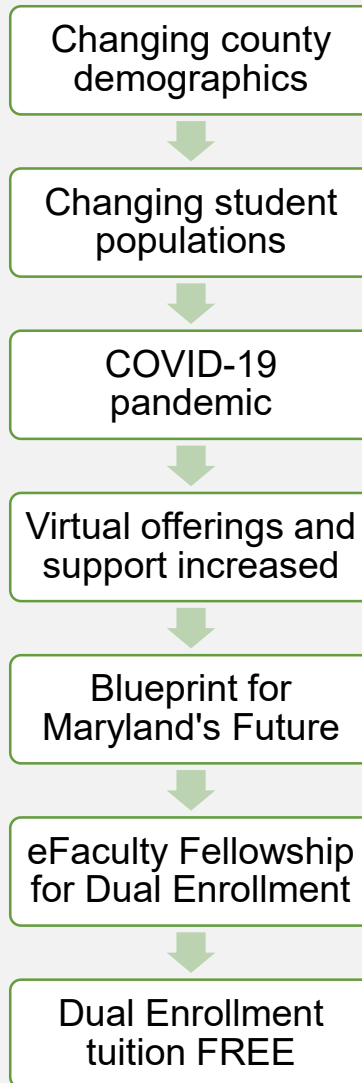

eFaculty Fellowship for Dual Enrollment



Virtual summer fellowship designed to enhance online and remote teaching of Dual Enrollment students



Relevant topics, best practices, and engaging strategies that bring innovation and inclusion to the virtual classroom



Open to all full-time and part-time faculty (priority given to faculty with interest in online or remote teaching)



Application process includes dean and chair approval

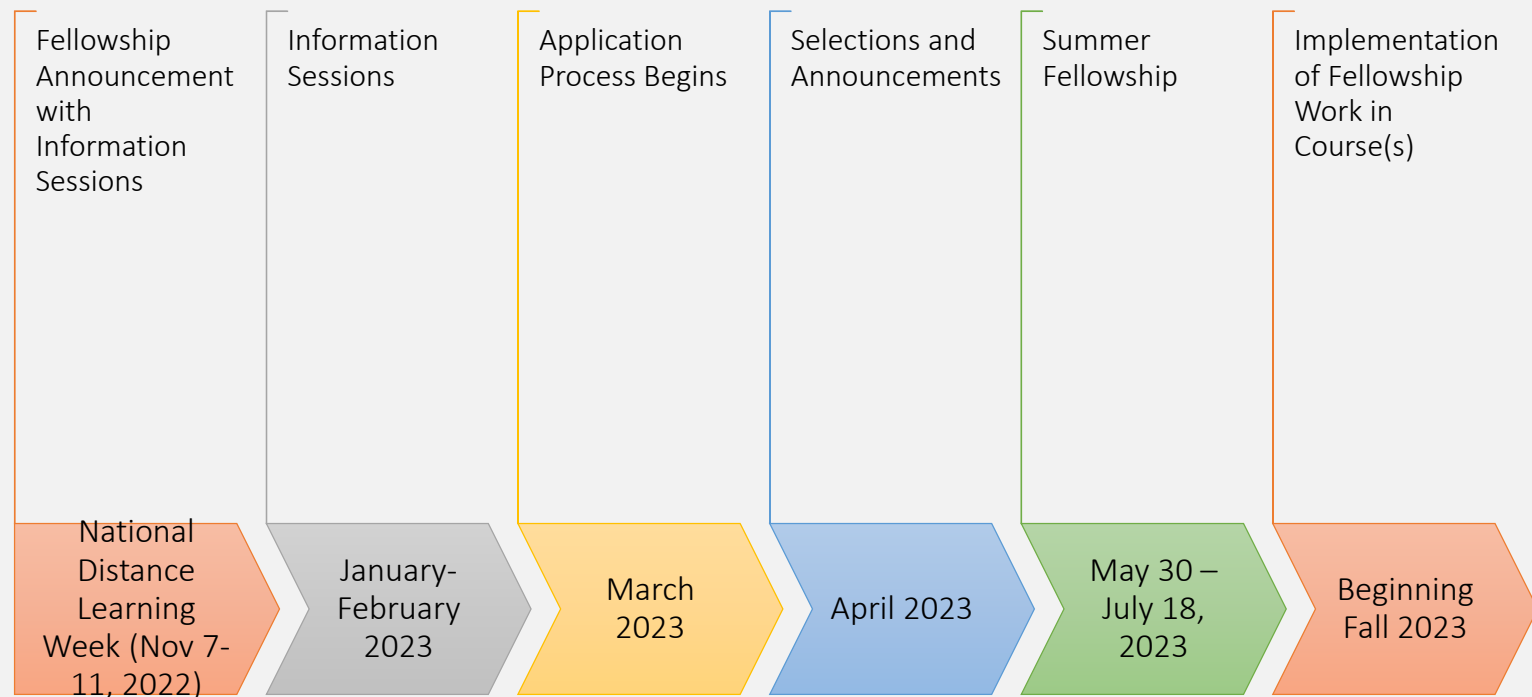
