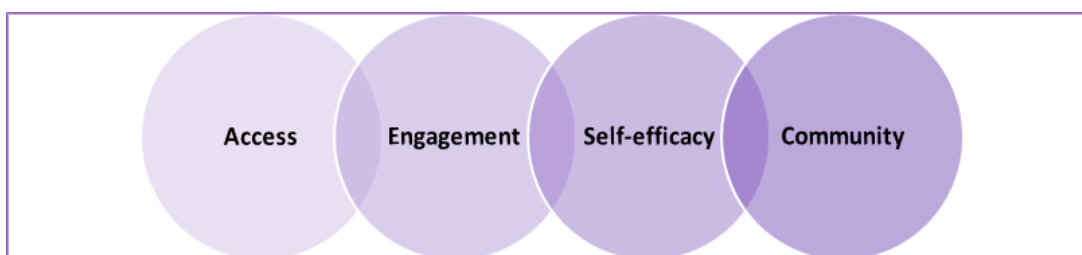
Vision Statement

Spotlight on Access and Engagement during Remote Teaching and Learning at MC **MC Learning Centers Support Student Success in 2020**

Inclusive Environment: Despite COVID-19, MC Learning Centers provided a **positive, welcoming, inclusive, antiracist environment to support students** in subjects including accounting, biology, chemistry, computer science, economics, ELAP, engineering, English, languages, mathematics, physics, and psychology.

Increase in Virtual Tutoring and Workshops: When the college transitioned to remote operations, every learning center **adapted quickly** to create **virtual tutoring** spaces. Each center saw **increased utilization** (often up to 100% capacity, with students waiting), resulting in **serious staffing challenges**.

Weekend Hours: While some centers have always had substantial availability on Saturdays and occasional availability on Sundays, other centers have *increased* **appointments on Saturdays** and have *added* **Sunday** hours.

Even More Collaboration: In order to promote **student success** *despite continued* resource constraints, the five STEM Learning Centers collaborated to *create* the **new Virtual STEM Learning Center** (with the **Talent Share Program providing help**), and the ASC and the three WRLCs collaborated with the **Libraries** to *share* **virtual resources**, including **workshops**.
