## Tips for Leveraging the 4C's - Marcy's Favorites



#### **Blackboard Collaborate and Zoom**

#### **Critical Thinking** Polling

Approach thinking using the questioning strategies and learning taxonomy



#### **Collaboration** Breakout Rooms

Use the grouping features to encourage collaboration



#### **Communication** Chat

Use the commenting feature to interact continually throughout class.



#### **Creativity** Whiteboard

Encourage students to use the whiteboard and drawing tools to openly display ideas, answers and corrections.







## Tips for Leveraging the 4c's- Michele's Favorites



**Critical Thinking** Ed Puzzle, transform your video materials by asking students open ended questions that require critical thinking





**Collaboration** Microsoft Office Tools (one drive, MS office, etc.) Use the commenting features to encourage collaboration





**Communication** Flipgrid, encourage students to practice communication with discussions that take place over live video





**Creativity** Adobe Spark Encourage students to use adobe spark to quickly develop assignments that encourage them to utilize storytelling skills
