C. Information and Update about college-wide Teaching and Learning Committee

- a. Shinta Hernandez and Mike Mills will be leading a Teaching and Learning Committee. The committee members will include the six ELITE Faculty Associates, one Instructional Designer from the ELITE team, a dean, a chair, and a part-time faculty representative. The Committee will provide professional development support and leadership from pre-boarding, through the first three years and beyond the first three years. After year three, faculty will transitioned to the Scholarship for Excellence in Teaching.
