- This is an effort to help keep the MC Community informed as we build a culture of evidence and inquiry



Fall Official Student Headcount









New Fall Students' Attempts and Completion of ENGLISH* "Gateway Course" in First Year





New Fall Students' Attempts and Completion of MATH* "Gateway Course" in First Year






Percentage of FTEIC Cohort that completed Gateway English in their first year





Completion of Gateway Courses for FTEIC


Percentage of FTEIC Cohort that completed Gateway Math in their first year






Completion of Gateway Courses for FTEIC

Percentage of FTEIC Cohort that completed Gateway Courses in their first year






Gateway English Completion in Year 1 by Race/Ethnicity

Gateway Math Completion in Year 1 by Race/Ethnicity














Attainment of Credit-Level Year 1 Milestones By New Students


For students starting as Full Time—Year 1 Milestone = 24 credits For students starting as Part Time—Year 1 Milestone = 12 credits
