


IRB Review Process -- What Happens When You Need an "IRB Review" (flow chart)



IRB Review Process -- What Happens When You Need an "IRB Review" (in words)

- 1 You make an inquiry and the IRB sends you an Application packet
OR You obtain an Application packet from the website
- 2 You complete and submit the Application packet to the Office of Institutional Research & Analysis either on paper or electronically
- 3 The IRB sends you acknowledgement of receipt of the Application and either asks you for more information or notifies you of the "next steps"
- 4 Your project may be "exempt" from IRB review based on your responses to the forms in the Application packet
Your project may require an "Expedited Review" by the IRB based on your responses to the forms in the Application packet
Your project may require a "Full Review" by the IRB based on your responses to the forms in the Application packet
- 5 You receive a formal notification of the outcome of the IRB review
- 6 You provide follow-up on project implementation and results
