FALL 2019 NEW TO COLLEGE A Snapshot of Enrollment

The Fall 2019 enrollment of the New-To-MC, ATD-tracking cohort is 3,931. This cohort is split almost 50-50 with regard to gender (50 percent female, 49 percent male). Their average age is 20, with 11 percent 25 years of age or older. Figure 1 provides a breakout by race ethnicity (IPEDS definition), with nearly one-third Hispanic.

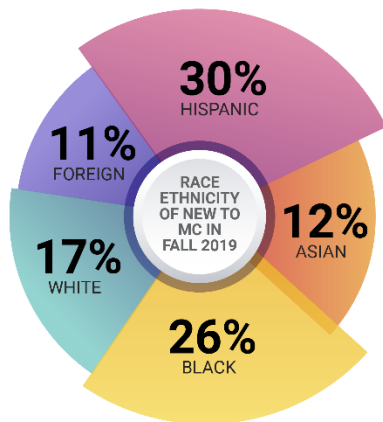

For those with a home country other than the U.S, the top five countries represented are El Salvador, Ethiopia, Cameroon, Peru, and Ghana. Nearly nine out of 10 (87 percent) are Montgomery County residents, with just about seven in 10 (69 percent) coming from a Montgomery County high school. More than one-third (39 percent) are Pell-eligible.

As of our 3rd week census day, over half (57.4 percent) were registered

full-time. The average number of total credit hours for the cohort is 10.6 translating into an average of 3.5 credit courses. In terms of fall 2019 credit course taking, the top 10 courses in which this cohort enrolled are listed in Table 1, with English and General Psychology landing in the top three.

For those in the cohort having already declared a major, General Studies account for 32 percent of the cohort. Table 2 provides a list of the cohort's top five programs of choice.
