We are pleased to share progress on the strategic plan refresh announced by President Jermaine F. Williams last month. We are also pleased to invite you to participate in the Collegewide Strategic Plan Refresh Forum on Thursday, January 19, 2023. Please <u>register now</u>.

Since the refresh was announced, we have two major activities to report. The first is the formation of the Strategic Plan Advisory Refresh Committee (or "SPARC"). This committee is composed of employees from across the College and is accompanied by a Student Work Group composed of students and a Community Work Group composed of community leaders. The employee members of SPARC are listed below. We thank the College Council, which was instrumental in recruiting potential members of the committee. The SPARC held its kickoff meeting last week and is structured with subcommittees that will focus on five major areas of interest:

- Student Success
- Employees
- Community
- Workforce and Partnerships
- Mission, Vision, and Values

In addition, members of the College Council met with the Board of Trustees in November to discuss the strategic plan refresh. Their conversation focused on ideas to maintain from the current strategic plan as well as ideas about the refreshed plan.

We want to expand that conversation to include the entire College community on January 19. The Collegewide Strategic Plan Refresh Forum will feature short presentations and interactive group activities to solicit transformative ideas about the College's refreshed strategic plan. The event will take place from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. Your involvement will be invaluable as the SPARC develops a draft plan, which is slated to be available for review by MC employees and students as well as community members in February and March. We encourage you to engage in this conversation and take every opportunity to make your voice heard. The final refreshed plan will be presented to the Board of Trustees in April.
