# The draft refreshed strategic plan is ready for your review. Please visit the <u>strategic plan</u> <u>refresh webpage</u>, read the plan, and share your thoughts. This review period starts today and ends on Friday, March 3. We thank you in advance for your participation in this important process to set the path for the College's future.

The draft refreshed plan builds on the current plan, *Montgomery College 2025 (MC 2025)*, with updates that are relevant for the needs of the College and our community in our post-pandemic world. This draft is the product of work by the Strategic Plan Advisory Refresh Committee (SPARC) with input from the College community gained especially through the collegewide forum held during professional week and attended by over 150 students, faculty, and staff.

### What You'll See

The draft plan includes newly stated Goals with accompanying Supporting Strategies and Intended Outcomes. The connection among these terms, new to the refreshed plan (not in *MC 2025*), is that **Goals** will be actualized by **Supporting Strategies** that lead to **Intended Outcomes**, which are tracked by **Indicators**. The draft refresh does not contain Indicators at this time. They will be developed once the Intended Outcomes are finalized.

In addition, the draft contains refreshed mission and vision statements and introduces a values statement to accompany the College's list of values.

#### What We Hope You'll Do

We invite you to visit the <u>refresh webpage</u> where you will find a PDF containing the draft plan. This document has three pages of introductory background material, followed by the Refreshed Mission, Vision, and Values on a single page, and then the Refreshed Strategic Plan in five pages. Read the document, think about it, talk with your colleagues, and then give us your feedback. We love hearing that you are inspired by it and can't wait to get to work on it. We also love hearing that you thought of something that's missing or something that could be improved. All of this feedback can be shared on the <u>form found at the bottom of the refresh webpage</u>.
