## Student Employment Service (SES) Report of Remote Service from March 13 to June 30, 2020

Student Employment Services (SES) moved all of its services online in March 2020 and collaborated with other agencies, departments, and employers to create virtual programming for students. Some of the highlights include; online federal resume workshops in partnership with FAPAC & OPM, partnered with Student Life on a 3-part pre-employment series, hosted a virtual job fair for JCC, and partnered with the Digital Learning Centers to provide weekly LinkedIn workshops for students. The SES team provided individual assistance to 328 students and 92 employers.
