

How do I apply for Financial Aid at MC



STEP 1: Complete a FAFSA

Submit your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). MC School Code: 006911



STEP 2: Submit documents

Check MyMC to access, complete and submit additional documents needed to complete your financial aid file.



STEP 3: Check MyMC

Check MYMC and your college email account often. Correspondence is sent to your official Montgomery College email address.

Montgomery College Financial Aid Summer 2026

Current MC Students: To receive summer financial aid, students must be in a degree-seeking program at Montgomery College and register ONLY for classes that lead to a degree in their major. We cannot provide aid to 'visiting' students.

Visiting Students: Visiting students are advised to consult the Montgomery College website for specific enrollment instructions. Montgomery College students attending a different institution for the summer term must submit a completed consortium agreement form.



If you are not eligible for financial aid for any reason, you will be responsible for 100% of all tuition and fee charges.

Which FAFSA for summer?

☐ — 2025-2026 FAFSA

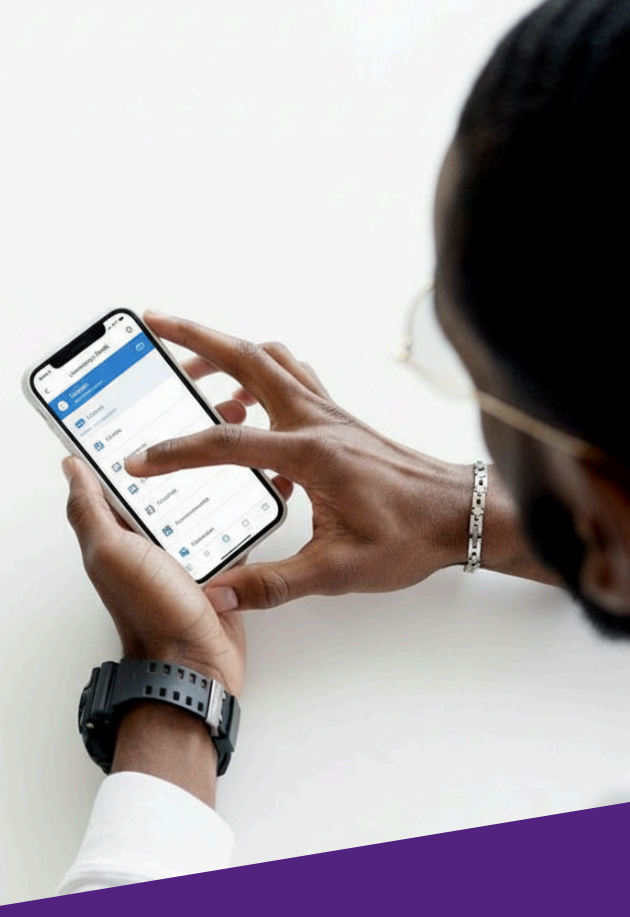
ALL students must complete the 2025-26 FAFSA by June 30, 2026. If you already received aid for fall/spring, you do not need to complete it again. Transfer students should add our school code (006911) to the FAFSA at studentaid.gov for us to receive your information.

🗓️ Pell Grant Eligibility

The financial aid office will calculate summer Pell grant eligibility based on the SAI number and enrollment level. Summer I and II are combined.

📅 Federal Direct Loan

You must enroll in at least six credit hours in summer 2026 in your program of study to qualify. Submit the Loan Change Form in MyMC.



Recent High School Grads

Financial aid opportunities are available for students graduating from high school in May or June. To establish Pell Grant eligibility, please complete the 2025-26 FAFSA by the June 30, 2026 deadline. To continue receiving aid for the 2026-27 academic year, you must complete the 2026-27 FAFSA.
