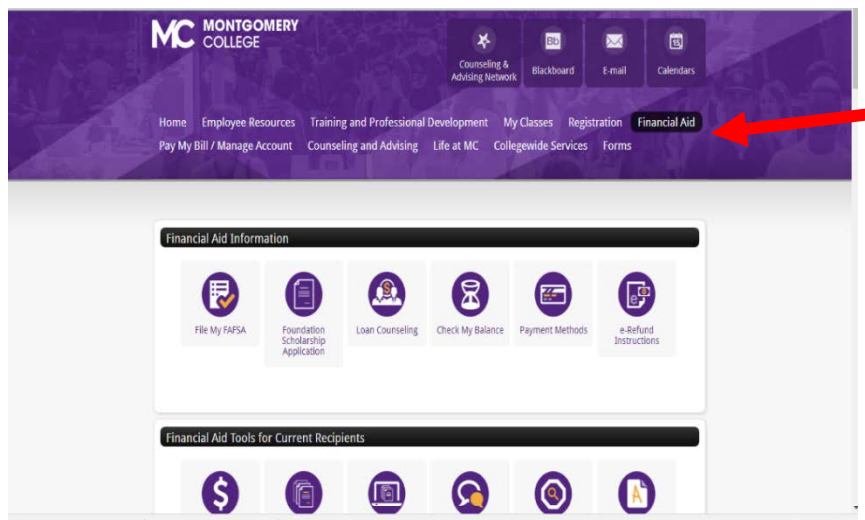


# Steps to Check Your Financial Aid Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP)

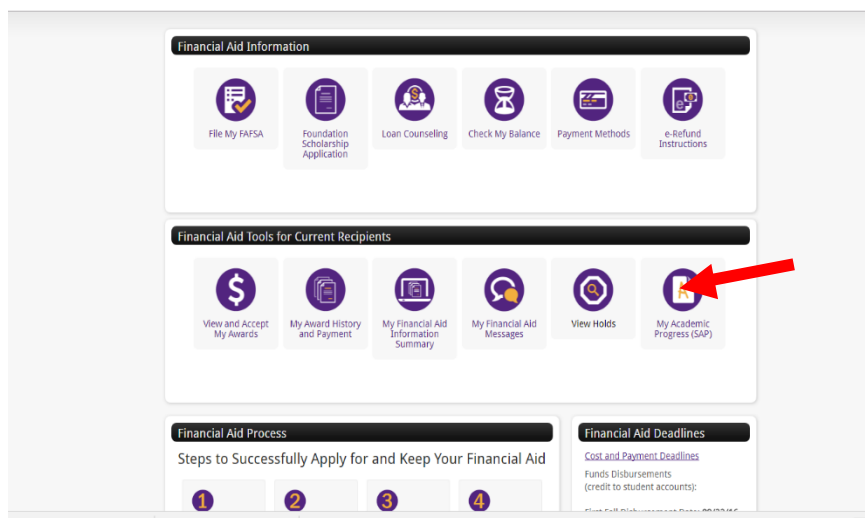
1) Log into your **MyMC**

[mymc.montgomerycollege.edu](http://mymc.montgomerycollege.edu)

2) Once logged in click on the **"Financial Aid"** tab.



3) Click on the **"My Academic Progress"** Button



4) Select the **Aid Year** that you need to check the SAP status for. For example, "2022-23 Academic Year" for Fall 22/Spring 23, "2023-24 Academic Year" for Fall 23/Spring 24 and like wise.

#### SATISFACTORY ACADEMIC PROGRESS (SAP)

The Office of Student Financial Aid evaluates SAP for aid applicants once a year at the end of the spring semester for most students. If you are in a certificate program or you are currently on a Satisfactory Academic Progress Course and Success Plan, your progress is reviewed each semester. Returning students, who were not enrolled for the spring evaluation, are reviewed for academic progress when MC receives their Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

**Current SAP STATUS evaluated as of term 201940: Reviewed and meets standards**

Students who are terminated from financial aid may appeal by submitting the appropriate appeal form to the financial aid office. The forms for appealing financial aid termination, Satisfactory Academic Progress Appeal Request, Satisfactory Academic Progress Appeal Update and Appeal for Aid Reestablishment can be found in the financial aid section of MyMC under Financial Aid Forms. Appeals for Updates and Reestablishment, unless otherwise requested, may be submitted at any time. SAP initial appeal request are accepted within a specified time frame each semester.

#### SAP CALCULATION

At the end of each semester Financial Aid runs the SAP calculation on your grades. Information below is solely for your knowledge and may help you to stay on track.

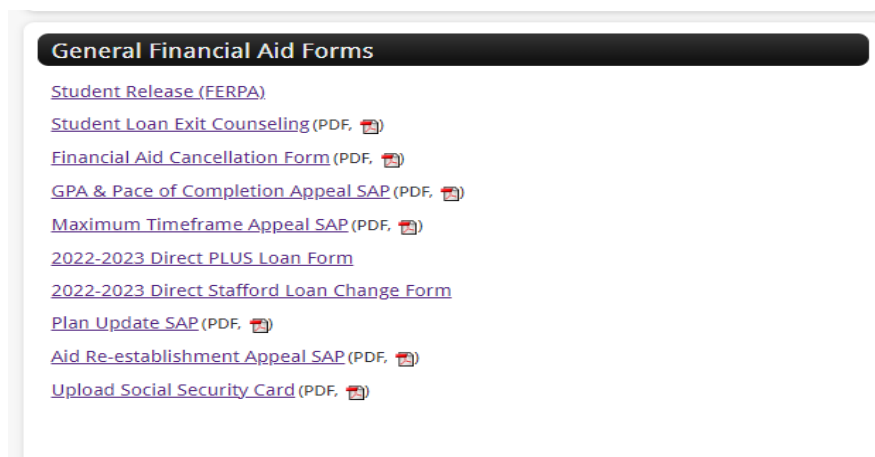
The following SAP calculation may be used to determine your SAP STATUS when its time for the evaluation. Failure to meet **any** of the following conditions, at the time of review, may result in termination from Financial Aid.

## 7) Appealing SAP Terminations

SAP Appeal Forms can be found on the financial aid page of MyMC, under the **General Financial Aid Forms** section. Please make sure that you review the deadline dates for the term you are appealing and submit the correct type of the SAP appeal form (see below).

### Satisfactory Academic Appeal Forms:

- GPA & Pace of Completion Appeal SAP** - Appeal form for students who are doing their first appeal for GPA and/or Pace of Completion termination and have never been on a plan.
- Maximum Time-frame Appeal SAP** - Appeal form for students who are doing their first appeal for Maximum Time-frame termination and have never been on a plan.
- Maximum Time-frame and GPA/Pace of Completion Appeal SAP** – Appeal form for students who are doing their first appeal for combination of Maximum Time-frame and GPA/Pace of completion termination and have never been on a plan.
- Plan Update Appeal SAP** - Appeal form for students who are appealing to update a previously approved Satisfactory Academic Progress Plan.
- Aid Re-establishment Appeal SAP** - Appeal form for students who received an administrative grade change (not a grade changed based on a repeated class).

**Satisfactory Appeal Deadline Dates:** Appeals received after the established deadlines will be reviewed for the next semester.
