- In Person:
 - Submit to one of our campus Raptor Central offices.
 - You must present an official copy in a **sealed envelope**. Transcripts not in envelopes sealed by the high school are not considered official and are not acceptable.
- Mailed through USPS
 - High school transcripts may also be submitted by mail, if mailed directly from your high school, school district, State Department of Education, or an Educational Evaluation Service.

- Electronic:
 - **Naviance** - High school transcripts may be submitted electronically by high schools that use Naviance.
 - **Parchment** - High school transcripts may be submitted electronically by high schools that use Parchment: parchment.com.
 - **Emailed** - High school transcripts may also be submitted if emailed directly from your high school, school district, State Department of Education, or an Educational Evaluation Service. Transcripts emailed from students are not considered official and are not acceptable.
