### Montgomery College Financial Aid Summer 2025

### Does Montgomery College offer student financial aid in the summer?

Yes, to receive summer financial aid, students must be in a degree seeking program at Montgomery College and register ONLY for classes that lead to a degree in their declared program of study (major) or approved certificate programs at MC as well as meet all other financial aid eligibility criteria. We cannot provide financial aid to "visiting" students who are pursuing degrees at other colleges or universities

If you are a visiting student – Please view the instructions for <u>visiting students</u> on the MC College website. If you are an MC student visiting another college for the summer please submit a consortium agreement <u>form</u>.

#### Which Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) do I complete for summer?

ALL students must complete the 2024-25 FAFSA by June 30, 2025 to receive financial aid for summer 2025. If you have already completed this form and received financial aid for the fall 2024 and/or spring 2025 semesters, you do not need to complete it again. Students transferring to MC from other schools should go to <u>www.studentaid.gov</u> and add MC's school code: 006911 to their FAFSA so the College can receive your information. If you did not attend MC in the fall or spring, but have registered for fall 2025 you must complete both the 2024-25 and 2025-26 FAFSAs.

## I received a Pell Grant in the fall and spring semesters of this academic year. Can I receive the grant for summer?

Yes, the financial aid office will calculate summer Pell grant eligibility based on the federal Student Aid Index (SAI) number and the level of enrollment for summer. Registered classes in Summer I and Summer II will be combined to determine a student's total summer enrollment.

Any amount of Pell received during the summer session counts towards a student's Lifetime Pell Grant eligibility.

#### May I borrow a Federal Direct Loan for summer?

You must have completed a minimum of six credit hours in the spring 2025 semester and enroll in at least six credit hours in summer 2025 (combined Summer I and Summer II enrollment) to qualify for a spring/summer Federal Direct Loan. If you were not enrolled during the 2024-25 school year, you may be able to borrow for summer only. If you borrowed your maximum annual loan eligibility during the fall 2024 and/or spring 2025 semesters, you may not have remaining Federal Direct Loan eligibility for summer 2025. Submit the Loan Change Form, located in the MyMC portal. "Click" on Financial Aid and scroll down to the "General Financial Aid Forms" box and select 2024-25 Direct Loan Change Form.

### Does MC offer any other grant assistance for summer?

Other grant assistance is usually not available for summer. If funds are available, they are awarded for summer session I to students who already have an application on file.

### Is there any financial aid for recent high school graduates?

Yes, if you graduate from high school in May or June 2025. To determine Pell Grant eligibility, you must complete the 2024-25 FAFSA by June 30, 2025. You must also complete the 2025-26 FAFSA to continue receiving aid for the 2025-26 school year.

#### Not eligible for summer aid?

If you are not eligible for financial aid for any reason, you will be responsible for 100% of all tuition and fee charges.
