Respondents who experienced sexual misconduct most likely experienced sexual harassment, stalking, or sexual exploitation



"I know where to report sexual misconduct." 59.2% of respondents



81.6% of students

have not experienced unwanted sexual violence or contact since coming to Montgomery College

The survey indicates that MC has a culture of respect where students feel empowered to speak up against sexual violence, to intervene in inappropriate situations, and to create an environment where survivors are supported.
