


2022-2023 Student Scholarships Study Abroad/In-Country

Partial Scholarships Ranging from \$500 to \$1.500



Awards also apply to Harriet Tubman in-country program.

Students who meet these qualifications and requirements may apply for the 2022-2023 Student Study Abroad Scholarships (deadline is November 15, 2022).

- Have a 2.5 G.P.A. and must be in good academic standing.
- Will have successfully completed a minimum of 12 Montgomery College credits by the beginning of the study abroad program.
- Are able to demonstrate the maturity and flexibility necessary to meet cultural and academic challenges abroad.
- Must be able to study abroad full time (if a long-term program is selected), or fully participate in academic activities and complete a project by the end of a short term program (meaning the **Trinidad** program is selected).
- Must have necessary health conditions to actively participate in short-term
- For long-term programs only, must fill out an "Application for Study Abroad" with foreign institution name and courses selected, which has been presented and approved by the Coordinator, Greg Malveaux, prior to applying for this scholarship.

- Must have graduated from high school within the last 10 years. Exceptions may be granted on an individual basis.
- Applicants are required to contact and hold a conference with the study abroad coordinator, Professor Malveaux (Greg.Malveaux@montgomerycollege.edu), prior to submitting an application, to be considered for a scholarship.

CHECKLIST

- 1) Completed application form
- 2) Unofficial transcript
- 3) 500-800 word statement explaining: 1) where you desire to study abroad,2) how the study abroad experience will complement your program of study and future goals, and 3) why you should be selected for a scholarship
- 4) Letter of reference from a Montgomery College faculty member or administrator in a sealed envelope



Note: Applicants with incomplete submissions (from the checklist above) will automatically be deemed ineligible.
