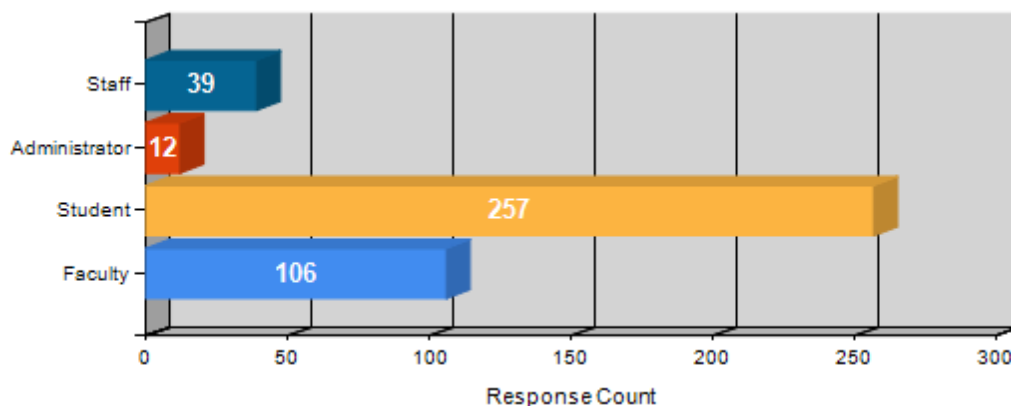


2013 Montgomery College Study Abroad Survey Results

During the spring 2013 semester, Montgomery College (MC) students, faculty, staff and administrators completed a survey on study abroad. The purpose of the survey was to identify the venues in which the audience would most like to participate in or lead a study abroad activity. The results bring increased awareness of the best practices that are necessary to serve the specific needs of the MC community. A summary of the survey results follows:

List the TOP 3 sites for faculty to visit to gain professional development.

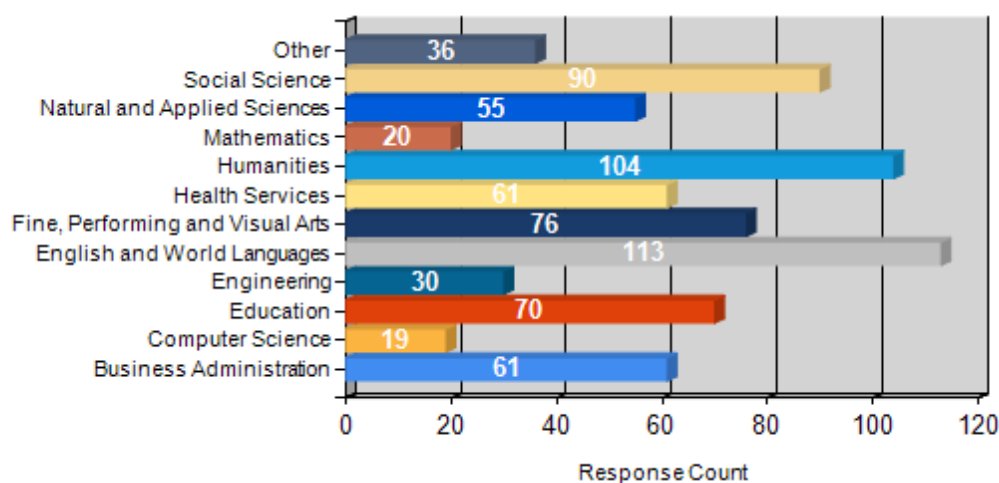

List the TOP 3 sites or attractions for students to visit to gain important scholarship.

Two hundred and three students picked a wide variety of sites and attractions that they wish to visit in order to gain important scholarship. Yet, no site or attraction garnered a significant majority of the responses. However, 12 percent of the students selected sites in Italy, 4 percent selected sites in France, and 4 percent sites in Spain.
