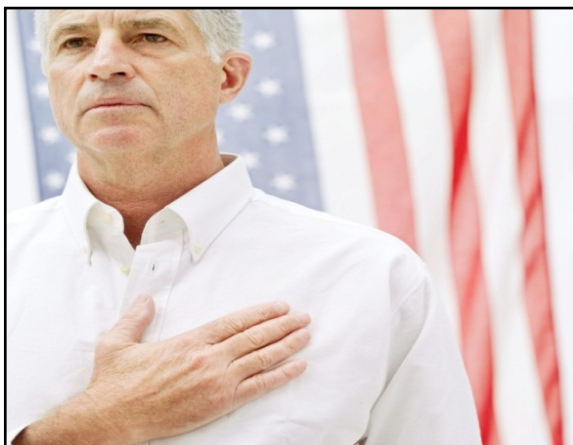


Citizenship Preparation Program
