Electrocardiograph Technician (EKG)

Course Dates: February-June 2020 (Monday-Thursday) • 6-9 p.m.

Program Description:

Improve your English, math, reading, study, computer, and work-related skills. Learn the function and proper use of the EKG machine, and how to perform electrocardiograms. Prepare to take the Electrocardiograph (EKG) Technician exam and work as part of a healthcare team of professionals. EKG technicians work in physician offices, hospitals, clinics, and other healthcare facilities.

Program Requirements

- You must be a Maryland resident.
- Must have a high school diploma.
- You must need help with English, reading, and/or math skills.
- You must be ready to study hard and to work in healthcare.
- Background in healthcare preferred (CNA/GNA certified)

Program Benefits

- FREE classroom and clinical training to prepare you for the EKG Technician exam.
- · Classes to help you with English, reading, and math skills for the test and job.
- Computer skills to help you on the job.
- Help finding a job, keeping a job, and moving up to the next job.


