Requirements

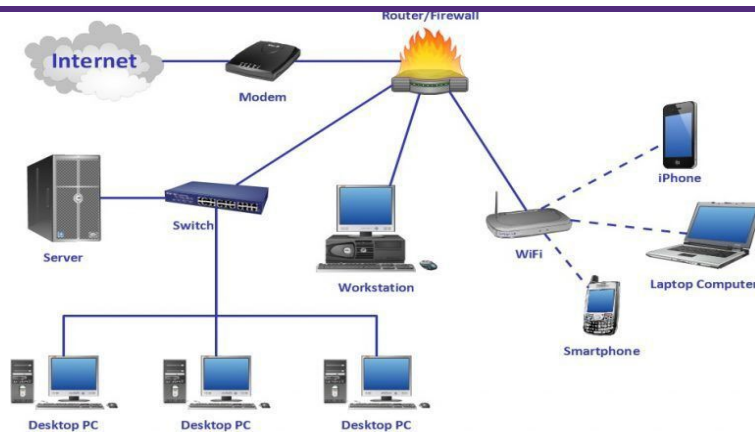
To apply for this course, you must:
