CLEP-a-THON is a drop-in test day at MC's Gaithersburg Business Training Center (located at 12 S. Summit Ave., 4th Floor, Gaithersburg, MD 20877).

We will be open for drop-in CLEP testing on Friday, August 4, 2023, from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. No appointment needed—just come in at a time that suits you!

#### Important Information:

Please bring your College Board exam ticket with you. Visit [collegeboard.org](https://collegeboard.org) to purchase your test ticket prior to coming. This ticket is necessary to load your test onto the computer.

- You will need to register and pay MC's \$30 testing fee when you arrive the day of testing. You can pre-print the registration form online; or, you can get the form at our office. Customer Service is located in Room 400.
- Check in will be in Room 404 beginning at 9:00 am. Testing will occur in Room 405.
- A valid federal ID with photo is required (ie, driver's license, passport, military ID, permanent resident card).
- You will be required to turn off your cell phone and any other electronics and leave them stored in Room 404. They are not allowed in the testing room. Preferably, you should leave electronics at home. Calculators are embedded in tests that require their use.
- We have a limit of 15 test takers at any one time. If we are full, you MAY have to wait for an open computer.
- Most tests are 90 minutes in length. Please make sure you allocate sufficient time in your schedule if you come to test.
- Students needing accommodations must contact Disability Support Services at 240-567-4118 at least 2 weeks in advance.

#### WHAT IS CLEP?

The College Board's College-Level Examination Program (CLEP) has been the most widely trusted credit-by-examination program for over 50 years, accepted by 2,900 colleges and universities and administered in more than 1,800 test centers. This rigorous program allows students from a wide range of ages and backgrounds to demonstrate their mastery of introductory college-level material and earn college credit. Students can earn credit for what they already know by getting qualifying scores on any of the 34 examinations.

While CLEP is sponsored by the College Board, only colleges may grant credit toward a degree. Not all colleges have the same CLEP policies—some colleges accept credit for a few exams, while others accept credit for all of them. A college often grants the same amount of credit to a student who earns satisfactory scores on a CLEP exam as it does for a student who successfully completes the related course.
