Purchase your exam ticket from College Board and email the ticket to clep@montgomerycollege.edu.

Visit collegeboard.org to purchase your test ticket prior to coming. This ticket is necessary to load your test onto the computer.

- Register online via MyMC or email us at clep@montgomerycollege.edu for registration form.
- Register and pay the \$30 fee prior to test date to ensure a seat.
- A valid federal ID with photo is required (ie, driver's license, passport, military ID, permanent resident card).
- Masks are required while in the testing room.
- You will be required to turn off your cell phone and any other electronics. They are not allowed in the testing room. Preferably, you should leave electronics at home. Calculators are embedded in tests that require their use.

WHAT IS CLEP?

The College Board's College-Level Examination Program (CLEP) has been the most widely trusted credit-by-examination program for over 50 years, accepted by 2,900 colleges and universities and administered in more than 1,800 test centers. This rigorous program allows students from a wide range of ages and backgrounds to demonstrate their mastery of introductory college-level material and earn college credit. Students can earn credit for what they already know by getting qualifying scores on any of the 34 examinations.

While CLEP is sponsored by the College Board, only colleges may grant credit toward a degree. Not all colleges have the same CLEP policies—some colleges accept credit for a few exams, while others accept credit for all of them. A college often grants the same amount of credit to a student who earns satisfactory scores on a CLEP exam as it does for a student who successfully completes the related course.
