Increasing Influence for Project Managers	PMC043	24166	Influence is the ability to have an effect on someone or something. Influence is used by project leaders throughout all phases of a project. Individuals can actively strengthen their influence to be more successful in the work environment- whether at the leadership level or not. Strengthening Effective Communication on Projects	PMC044	24167	This course provides a basic understanding of the fundamentals of effective communication and reviews how communication can help lead to project success. Topics covered include active listening, audience identification, purpose definition, and effective delivery. Sustaining Resilience on Projects and Life	PMC045	24168	This course provides insight into what makes people resilient. The inherent risk of project environments requires resiliency. Insight and practical application opportunities will be provided to help participants strengthen their resilience and ensure they can sustain it over a long period. Handling Conflicts on Project Teams	PMC047	24169	Conflict is a natural occurrence when people work on teams - in fact, it is an aspect of one stage of team development. This conflict can negatively impact project success. This course prepares the project management professional to understand and manage conflict on project teams.
