

WDCE Bridge to Academic and Career Success Program

Students will be directed to the academic coordinator of bridge based on the information exchanged in the MC English Remote Placement (<https://www.montgomerycollege.edu/admissions-registration/assessments.html>). Once connected with the academic coordinator, the student will take a standardized reading assessment to determine which placement is the best fit, The WDCE Bridge Program or the Connected reading and Writing Class. The Bridge Program is intended for students that test at a minimum of an 8th grade reading level. Connecting Reading and Writing is intended for students that test between 5th and 7th grad reading levels.

The academic coordinator will provide the reading assessment to students that helps to determine Bridge Program versus Connecting Reading and Writing placement on a rolling basis, Tuesday and Thursdays. Participation in the WDCE Bridge Program requires registration in all three courses, Student Success and Career Planning, Reading Comprehension, and Writing Comprehension, I the same group. Books and materials necessary for class can be purchased through the Montgomery College Bookstore. In addition, you must have access to WI-FI and a laptop, tablet or desk computer.
