STEAM Day with MC Youth

STEAM Day with MC Youth Programs

Come join us for a full day of STEAM. You will participate in two three-hour sessions. One session focuses on vaccine production, biotechnology, techniques/work practices used in the biotechnology lab to work safely, and the laboratory skills you need to develop for producing a vaccine. The other session focuses on engineering and art. You will design and build a flower from a color changing LED and craft items. Then you will add movement to the stem or petals using a servo motor, programmed and powered using the Arduino Nano, a member of the Arduino family of microcontroller boards that is small enough to fit inside a flower pot. You will participate in BOTH sessions, and have a break for lunch in between. Come spend a Saturday immersed in STEAM activities in the state-ofthe-art Montgomery College facilities
